



John Kiff

Since 2005, John Kiff has been a Senior Financial Sector Expert at the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Prior to that, John worked at the Bank of Canada for 25 years, where he spent most of his time managing the funding and investment of the government's foreign exchange reserves.

During his last five years at the Bank, John was heavily involved in several BIS working groups that focused on credit risk transfer markets, and he has published a number of articles and papers around these projects.
