Giulio is the head of the Group Operational Risk Management department at Intesa Sanpaolo (former Sanpaolo IMI).

He is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Operational Riskdata eXchange association (ORX) and has started the ORX Analytics Working Group chairing it from 2003 to 2006.

Giulio has over 13 years of post-PhD experience. His current role is to define and manage the OR framework in the Group including criteria, methodologies and processes for measuring and managing operational risk in line with the international best practice and regulatory requirements. Prior to 2002, he was a market risk analyst. In 1995-97 he spent two years as a scientific associate in CERN - the world's largest particle physics laboratory.

Giulio has played an active role in the definition of the operational risk measurement international best practice. He is a member of the Working Group on Operational Risk of the Institute for International Finance which is actively involved in the Basel 2 lobbying process.

Giulio has published more than twenty research papers in respected scientific journals such as the Journal of OR. He has contributed chapters to books such as "The Advanced Measurement Approach to Operational Risk", edited by Operational Risk magazine. He is a frequent speaker at international conferences including GARP, ICBI, Marcus Evans.

Giulio has a Masters degree in Nuclear and Sub-Nuclear Physics and Astrophysics and a PhD in Theoretical Physics from Torino University.
