Marco Moscadelli is head of the operational risk team at the Bank of Italy, where he is in charge of validating the AMA and supervising the operational risk framework of the Italian banking groups. He also share responsibilities for the implementation and maintenance of the domestic regulation on operational risk.

He leads the Sub Group on Operational Risk (SGOR) established inside the Committee of European Banking Supervisors (CEBS). He is also member of the Standards Implementation Group on Operational Risk (SIGOR) of the Basel Committee.

He gave several courses and lectures on operational risk in Academics circles, Financial Institutions and Supervisory Bodies, including the Financial Stability Institute of the Basel Committee

His research focuses on quantification of operational risk, in particular on the comparison between conventional actuarial distributions and models stemming from the Extreme Value Theory.

In 2006 he was elected "Regulator of the Year" by the Operational Risk & Regulation magazine.
