



### **Alberto G. Brugnoni**

Is the former director for Italy with Merrill Lynch Bank, is an independent Islamic finance adviser. His first Shariah-compliant activities date back to the mid-'80s with the execution of pioneering *murabaha* and *mudharaba* transactions. In 1986 he attended one of the first congress of Islamic finance ever organized in Washington DC by the US State Department. In 1997 he released 'Pilot Project Genoardo,' a seminal study for the establishment of a Mediterranean development bank based on Shariah compliant principles.

He is the founder and Chairman of the Board of ASSAIF ([www.assaif.org](http://www.assaif.org)) possibly the oldest European think tank on Islamic Finance focusing at present on microfinance, social design, accountancy and monetary issues. It also offers professional consultancy and training in legal, fiscal, administrative, financial engineering and marketing areas related to Islamic finance. ASSAIF works with governments, central banks, public and private institutions, local and regional authorities, professional practices and investors helping them to structure Shariah-compliant deals.

Alberto has authored some of the most innovative projects on financial and social exclusions in recent years, amongst them 'NuoviStilidiVita' on behalf of the European Commission. He regularly chairs the world major events on Islamic Finance and gives presentations in Italian, French, English and Arabic.
