Ian Linnell is a group managing director at Fitch Ratings and head of Fitch's European structured finance group. This group is responsible for providing credit ratings on asset-backed securities (ABS), covered bonds, residential mortgage and commercial mortgage-backed securities (RMBS and CMBS).

Previously, Ian was in charge of Fitch's bank group covering the European, Middle Eastern, and African regions, a position he held for three years. Prior to moving to the bank group, Ian set up Fitch's credit policy group (CPG) for the non-Americas. CPG, which he headed for three years, is responsible for monitoring the overall quality of Fitch's ratings as well as reviewing and developing internal procedures and governance policies. Before joining CPG, he was a regional director in Fitch's financial institutions group, where he was responsible for rating, analyzing, and developing company criteria for Scandinavia, Switzerland, and major UK financial institutions.

Prior to joining Fitch, Ian worked as an analyst with Standard & Poor's for five years. Earlier, he was an economist and a banking supervisor for the Bank of England.

Ian earned a BA in economics from Newcastle Upon Tyne University.
