

## Short Biography



Victor Kjær is Deputy General Director of the Danish Commerce and Companies Agency (the DCCA), which belongs to the Danish Ministry of Economic and Business Affairs. The DCCA is responsible for implementing the Danish Governments Action Plan for Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), and acts as a secretariat for the Danish Council for Corporate Responsibility. Victor Kjær is responsible for the CSR activities of the DCCA, as well as for company law regulation and control of financial reports from listed companies.

Previously Victor Kjær has among other things been General Director of the Danish Consumer Agency, where he in particular was leading a major project on consumers and biotechnology and also for establishing a business code for good customer relations.

Victor Kjær has also been Deputy General Director of the Danish Telecom Agency, where he was responsible for implementing the Danish Governments policy for promoting new communication and information technologies.

Before that Victor Kjær was for many years a Director in the Danish Ministry of Economic and Business Affairs, where he was in charge of business regulation, financial service regulation and competition regulation.
